About your course

The effective management of complex chronic wounds requires specialist skills, knowledge and understanding. We firmly believe in the importance of education and the sharing of expertise and experience.

This course is suitable for registered practitioners who see patients with mild or chronic swelling or people who are either at risk of or, who currently have a lower leg wound.

If symptoms or conditions affecting the veins or lymphatic system are not addressed early enough they can transform into more severe problems such as, increasing oedema and breakdown of skin leading to ulceration. Attendance at this training will empower you with the knowledge of three early intervention pathways to promote the earliest possible intervention with the aim of avoiding complexities in management and swiftly improving the lives of your patients.

Pathways for early intervention

- Wounds on the lower leg and ankle
- Lymphorrhoea and Chronic Oedema
- Mild venous disease, or pregnancy related swelling

How the course is run

The training will be held using our virtual learning environment (VLE) with pre and post learning quizzes, presentations (pre-recorded and live) and Q & A sessions.

You will need to have access to a laptop, tablet or computer with video and sound capability so you can access the VLE effectively. You will also need peace and quiet!
