# About your course

This course is suitable for registered practitioners who see patients with chronic swelling.

**The leg ulcer and lymphoedema core training must be completed before undertaking this course.**

## Session 1 - assessment & management of lymphoedema - on-line (Zoom)

A guide to patient assessment and management of patients with lower limb oedema including assessment and management of chronic oedema/lymphoedema.

## Session 2 - practical bandaging - face to face workshop

You must have attended the assessment and management of lymphoedema Zoom session previously.

Practical workshop of compression bandaging below knee and full limb for lymphoedema management using different sizes of short stretch bandages to achieve graduated compression.

## How the course is run

**Session 1** will be held on-line using the Zoom platform with pre and post learning quizzes, presentations (pre-recorded and live) and Q & A sessions.

You will need to have access to a laptop, tablet or computer with video and sound capability so you can access the Zoom platform effectively. You will also need peace and quiet!

Zoom is FREE, easy to download and simple to use - you will need to have your account set up and tested in advance of the training day to ensure there are no connectivity issues.

It's a good idea to have a trial meeting with a friend or colleague to make sure your audio and video are working properly.

We will be using the chat, break out and polling features of Zoom during the course to make the session interactive and we would ask you to participate as if in a face to face situation.

**Session 2** will be a face to face practical bandaging workshop which will be held at Accelerate Head Office in the Garden Room, St. Joseph's Hospice, Mare Street, Hackney E8 4SA.

NB please wear suitable clothing for a practical session.
